- 1. **Rosary before the Blessed Sacrament** During the Month of May, Rosary before the Blessed Sacrament will be held at 6:55pm every day except when the bulletin schedule expresses otherwise.
- 2. **Rogation Days** The three days preceding Ascension Thursday are Rogation Days. A procession and Mass will be had on Monday and Tuesday beginning at 6:30 am. Wednesday the 8<sup>th</sup> is also the vigil of the Ascension, therefore there will be a Sung Mass in the morning for the vigil of the Ascension at 6:50 am, I Vespers of the Ascension at 5:20 pm and the Rogation procession and Mass will be at 7:00 pm.
- 3. Ascension Thursday May 9th is Ascension Thursday, a traditional Holy Day of Obligation. The schedule is that of Sunday, with the addition of a 6:30 p.m. Low Mass in the evening.
- 4. **Confirmations** The sacrament of confirmation will be conferred on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May 2024. If you would like to receive this sacrament, please fill out a form located in the vestibule by May 5<sup>th</sup>.
- First Holy Communions Please note that this year First Holy Communions will be on May 12. On Saturday, the 11<sup>th</sup> of May there will be a Recollection in the morning for all those preparing for their First Holy Communion. Details are forthcoming.
- 6. **Easter Duty** All Catholics have the grave obligation of receiving the Holy Eucharist worthily once a year around Easter. The faithful in the United States can fulfill this obligation anytime between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday, which is the first Sunday after Pentecost.
